## Morning (Summer)

1. Fill the food trough using chicken food located in the metal trash can. (Do not overfill.)

2. If the water level in either water trough (inside or outside) is low, fill with fresh water from the rain barrels. Do this by opening the spigot on the left barrel and then the spigots (one at a time) at the troughs. Close ALL spigots when done.

3. Unlatch the front hatch from inside the coop.

4. Go outside and open the front hatch, securing it open with the carabiner and rope.

5. Place the wooden plank on the deck so the chickens can descend to the ground.

6. Check the nesting boxes (and elsewhere!) for eggs and place them in a carton.

7. Log the date and time of day, number of chickens, and number of eggs collected in the Peeps Notebook. Note any injuries, illness, or anything else that doesn't look quite right.

8. Take home your share of eggs. Leave the rest in a carton for the next shift.

- 9. Close the coop's back door (the human door) and latch it.
- 10. Close, latch, and lock the gate when you leave the chicken yard. Thank you!
